The Secret Life of Bee

Na Myung Hwa used to cause pain to those around her, but now she trains others to spread the good news in Seoul, South Korea. Before accepting Christ in college, Na Myung Hwa's nickname was "Bee" for her sharp, stinging personality. She mocked the phrase "heavenly Father," challenging Christians to ask God to hug her if He was so real. However, at 21 years old, she passed by a church and was drawn in by the beautiful singing she heard. She started visiting a church with an aunt, and began to understand Jesus' death and sacrifice.

These days, Na Myung Hwa (at right and below) is an instructor, coaching her students as they role-play discussions using a curriculum developed by Campus Crusade for Christ called New Life Training Centers. NLTC lessons train students of all ages to be sure of their faith, explain it well to others and then—a critical part—to continue meeting and talking with people with whom they have had a spiritual conversation.

Na Myung Hwa was a member of the first NLTC class at KwangChun Church in Seoul 11 years ago. Since beginning the NLTC classes, the church has seen the membership more than quadruple from 500 to 2,200.
