OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD PACKING PARTY - is

set for next Sunday, October 4 at 2:00 p.m. and we will begin by meeting in the auditorium. We have set a goal of packing 400 boxes as a church. You can help in one of four ways. First, you can help by giving as we need \$3,600 to ship 400 boxes and we could use extra funds to purchase materials to pack at the packing party.
